ITEM 100**GOVERNING PUBLICATIONS**

This tariff is governed, except as otherwise provided, by the following described publications, supplements thereto, and successive reissues thereof:

- (a) Mileage Guide, 100-Series, issued by American Moving & Storage Association, Inc., Agent
- (b) Rules Tariff, CASR 100-J, issued by Casco Services, Inc.

ITEM 150**APPLICATION OF TARIFF**

Rates and charges in this tariff apply on:

- (a) FREIGHT, All Kinds, in straight or mixed shipments, moving in containers or trailers furnished by the shipper, consignee, water or motor carrier, between points in the United States.
- (b) EMPTY CONTAINERS OR TRAILERS, when loaded units have been, or will be, transported under the provisions of paragraph (a) herein.

ITEM 300**ADVANCING CHARGES**

- (a) Carrier will advance charges of other carriers, or for loading or unloading, or such other special services as are incurred with other transportation entities, piers, wharves, other waterborne facilities, warehouses and the like, for collection with lawful transportation charges.
- (b) For charges advanced for loading or unloading, or for per diem rental or storage charges less than \$25.00, no fee will be assessed. For the advancement of all other charges, a fee of 10% of the amount advanced will be assessed, subject to a minimum charge per shipment of \$10.00.
- (c) Charges will be described on carrier's freight bill in such manner as to accurately describe their exact character.
- (d) On request, carrier will provide copies of invoices submitted by such other entities to the party paying the advance charges.

ITEM 330**ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE SHIPMENTS**

Shipments requiring an alcoholic beverage license to transport will be subject to an additional charge of \$30.00, in addition to all other lawful charges.

ITEM 360**BILL OF LADING TERMS**

Shipments as described herein must move under bills of lading to include the following:

- (a) Loaded container or trailer movements – Bills of lading must be endorsed with the notation "shipper weight, load, count and seal." Or like import, and must specify:
 - (1) Container or trailer number(s)
 - (2) Tare weight of unit
 - (3) Weight of contents
- (b) Empty trailer or container movements – Bill of lading must be endorsed to indicate trailer or container is empty.

RULES

ITEM 382 CANCELLING ORIGINAL AND REVISED PAGES, EXCEPT THE TITLE PAGE

- (a) When this tariff is amended by revised pages, the cancellation or prior pages, except the title page, will be effected by means of this rule. A revised page will not show a cancellation notice except when a cancellation notice is necessary because of suspension, rejection, or other reason. Revisions of each page will be published and filed in numerical sequence.
- (b) Except where a specific cancellation is shown on a new revised page, a revised page cancels any and all un-cancelled revised or original pages, or un-cancelled portions thereof, which bear the same page number (SEE EXCEPTION). For example, 1st revised Page 10 will have the effect of cancelling Original Page 10; 45th Revised Page 12 will have the effect of cancelling 44th Revised Page 12, 13th Revised Page 4-A will have the effect of cancelling 12th Revised Page 4-A and also 11th Revised Page 4-A, if the cancellation of 12th takes place or on before its effective date.

EXCEPTION: When a specific cancellation on a prior revised page except a previously files page wholly or in part, this rule does not have the effect of cancelling such excepted previous page or portion thereof.

ITEM 430C.O.D. SHIPMENTS

- (a) Carrier will accept collection on delivery (COD) shipments only under the provisions of this item.
- (b) Shipments must be tendered on uniform bills of lading.
- (c) The letters "COD" must be typed, stamped or written on all such bills of lading and shipping orders immediately before the name of the consignee, OR the letters "COD" must be stamped in red in letters at least one inch in height across the face of the bill of lading and shipping order.
- (d) Only on COD amount may be shown and is not subject to change based on time or conditions of payment.
- (e) Bills of lading must clearly indicate the following information:

Collect on delivery \$ _____ and remit to:
 Name _____
 Street _____
 City _____ State _____ Zip _____
 COD Charges are to be paid by:
 Shipper Consignee

- (f) Each package must be plainly marked, labeled or tagged by consignor showing the letters "COD" and the name and address of consignor and consignee.
- (g) COD packages will not be accepted on the same bill of lading with other than COD freight. Only packaged covered by one COD bill of lading.
- (h) If consignor desires to forward invoice or collection papers, they must be securely attached to the shipping order copy bill or lading, which copy must bear the following notation:
 "Attached invoice(s) to accompany shipment to destination"
- (i) COD shipments will not be accepted when billed to one firm or person but with instructions to collect from another party.
- (j) COD shipments will not be accepted for transportation subject to inspection or trial by consignee, or where instructions indicate partial delivery. Carrier is responsible to deliver shipment in accordance with the bill of lading contract. If, for any reason, upon presentation upon delivery, COD payment is refused by the consignee, carrier is responsible for the disposition of the shipment only in accordance with the bill of lading contract and applicable tariff provisions. Carriers in such circumstances are not responsible to seek or remit the COD amount to the consignor or owner of the goods.

ITEM 430 -- Concluded

C.O.D. SHIPMENTS

- (k) The amount COD bill for COD shipments must be collected at the time of delivery of such shipments.
- (l) Only the following form of payment will be accepted in payment of COD shipments:
- (1) Cash, up to a maximum of \$250.00
 - (2) Bank cashier's check
 - (3) Bank certified check
 - (4) Money order
 - (5) Personal check of the consignee when so authorized in writing by consignor, or by endorsement on the bill of lading and shipping order by consignor.
- (m) All checks and money orders shall be made payable to the consignor. Carrier will accept checks or money orders only as the agent of the consignor, and carrier's responsibility is limited to the exercise of due care and diligence in forwarding such checks and money orders to the consignor.
- (n) The charge for collecting and remitting COD amounts will be collected from the consignee unless the consignor indicates that such charge is to be prepaid. Collection and remittance for freight charges or other lawful chafes shall be made payable to the carrier, and such amounts shall not be included with checks or money orders covering COD amounts payable to the consignor. Indication of prepayment of the COD fee shall be by appropriate endorsement on the bill of lading and shipping order.
- (o) Carrier shall remit COD amount promptly to the consignor or other persons designated as payee, but no later than 10 days following delivery of the shipment.
- (p) Carrier will maintain a record of COD shipments in a manner that will plainly provide the following information:
- (1) Number and date of freight bill
 - (2) Name and address of shipper, or other person designated as payee.
 - (3) Name and address of consignee.
 - (4) Date shipment delivered.
 - (5) Amount of COD.
 - (6) Date collected by carrier.
 - (7) Date remitted payee.
 - (8) Check number or other identification of remittance to payee.
- (q) Carrier, upon written request from consignor, will change the status of a COD shipment, by increasing, reducing or cancelling the COD amount. Such request must be received by the carrier prior to tender of delivery of the shipment, and will be made at a charge of \$25.00. Carrier does not obligate itself to effect such change, but will make reasonable effort to do so. The charge provided in this paragraph must be guaranteed to the satisfaction of the carrier by the consignor.
- (r) Carrier, upon written request from consignor, will change the form of payment of the COD amount to that of consignee's personal check, when such form of payment was not initially indicated, subject to an additional charge of \$25.00, such payment to be prepaid or guaranteed by consignor.
- (s) If request for conversion of payment form is received after initial tender of delivery of the shipment, and shipment was refused by the consignee, shipment will also be subject to redelivery charges in Items 830 (REFUSAL AND REDELIVERY).
- (t) A charge of \$50.00 will be assessed for the collection of COD amounts.

ITEM 435

COLLECTION OF CHARGES

- (a) When credit has been established between carrier and consignor, consignee, or third party in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration, or other Federal governing body, the provisions of this item will apply.
- (b) The standard credit period shall extend fifteen (15) calendar days (including Saturdays, Sundays, and legal Holidays) from the first 12 o'clock midnight following presentation of the freight bill by carrier, or the deposit of same in the U.S Mail, the postmark date on carrier's transmittal envelope shall control.
- (c) When carrier's freight bill has not been paid within the standard credit period, carrier will extend the credit periods, and the consignor, consignee, or third party will be assessed a service charge equal to 1.5% per month (18% per annum) of the amount of carrier's total freight bill, subject to a minimum of service charge of \$10.00 per freight bill, for such extension of credit.
- (d) The service charge will be applied commencing the day following the last day of their standard credit period regardless of the date the payment is actually received by the carrier.
- (e) For the purposes of this rule, mailing within the standard credit period by the consignor, consignee, or third party of acceptable checks, drafts or money orders in payment of freight bills shall be deemed to be the collection of the applicable tariff charges within the credit period. In case of dispute as to the date of mailing, the postmark date on the transmittal envelope shall be controlling.

NOTE: By imposing the service charge for the extension of credit, carrier seeks to prevent a consignor, consignee, or third party from having free use of funds due the carrier. Carrier does not sanction payment delays; the failure of a consignor, consignee, or third party to pay within the authorized credit period will, despite the provision for a service charge, require carrier, before again extending credit, to determine in good faith whether consignor, consignee, or third party will comply with the credit regulations in the future. Carrier reserves the right to withhold credit arrangements from any party not making payments within the standard credit period.

ITEM 475

CROSS REFERENCE TO TARIFFS, ITEM, NOTES OR RULES

Where reference is made herein to a tariff, item, note or rule, or other provisions, such reference will include any supplemental corrections or successive reissue of same.

ITEM 485

DEDUCTIONS OF LOSS OR DAMAGE CLAIMS

Deductions of loss and damage claims from freight charges without prior carrier approval are prohibited.

◆ ITEM 500

DETENTION OF VEHICLES

APPLICABLE ONLY when delay or detention is attributable to consignor, consignee, or others designated by them.

SECTION 1 – FREE TIME

(a) Except as otherwise provided, the following free time will be allowed:

<u>SERVICE LEVEL</u>	<u>FREE TIME</u>
(1) On shipments moving under driver and tractor "stay with" basis during Loading or unloading	120 minutes
(2) On shipments moving under a "drop and pull" basis; i.e., the trailer is Spotted to be Loaded or unloaded and does not include the services of the driver or power unit	30 minutes
On shipments where the loaded or empty container is picked up from or returned to a water carrier, NVOCC, motor or rail terminal.	60 minutes
(4) On shipments moving under the provisions of ITEM 900 (STOPOFFS).	60 minutes

(b) Free time per vehicle shall begin at the time the driver notifies consignor or consignee, or party entitled to load or unload, that the trailer or container is available for loading or unloading, and shall terminate when loading or unloading is completed and carrier's vehicle is released from further service.

SECTION 2 – CHARGES

When loading or unloading exceeds the free time described above, charges will be:

- (a) For the first hour or fraction thereof after expiration of free time \$65.00
- (b) For each additional 15 minutes, or fraction thereof\$16.25

SECTION 3 – ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS

- (a) Detention charges as provided herein will apply only between the hours of 8:00AM and 5:00PM, inclusive, Mondays thru Fridays, except Holidays. At all other times, the detention charge will be \$21.25 per 15 minutes, or fraction thereof, in excess of free time provided.
- (b) Free time and detention charges under this item will be computed only for the time the power unit and driver are detained at the loading or unloading site. If free time or detention has not ended at the close of the day on which service is provided, it will be resumed at the start of the next day on which consignor, consignee or other party at whose site loading or unloading is to be performed, requests resumption of services, subject to an additional charge of:
 - (1) \$100.00, if the applicable rate basis number (Section 2) is less than 30.
 - (2) \$200.00, if the applicable rate basis number (Section 2) is 30 or more.
- (c) When SECTION 7 of the bill of lading terms and conditions is executed, carrier will not deliver shipment to consignee unless detention charges, if accrued, are guaranteed in writing

ITEM 500-1 DETENTION OF VEHICLES -- SECOND DAY SERVICE

- (a) When a trailer or container is loaded or unloaded on a "stay with" basis, and the load or empty cannot be returned to the appropriate terminal on the same day, a second day service charge of \$125.00 will be assessed for the completion of the movement on the next working day, in addition to all other applicable charges.
- (b) Completion of a shipment includes pickup of load or empty trailer, delivery or pickup of freight and return of load or empty to appropriate terminal.

ITEM 501 RAILROAD DETENTION CHARGES (RAIL STORAGE) (NOTE A)

When carrier is notified by a railroad that a trailer or container is available for pickup, and the consignee cannot schedule to receive a vehicle within the allowed free time in accordance with the following schedule:

RAILROAD / STEAMSHIP LINE	FREE TIME -- DAY OF NOTICE PLUS	STORAGE CHARGE PER DAY	CUT OFF TIME (NOTE B)
AMERICAN PRESIDENT LINES (PACER)	2 DAYS	\$75.00	5:00PM
CSX (PRIVATE)	2 DAYS	\$75.00	5:00PM
NORFOLK SOUTHERN	1-4 DAYS (NOTE C)	\$75.00	5:00PM

NOTE A: Also includes similar facilities operated by steamship lines.

NOTE B: Cutoff time is the time after which notification constitutes effective notification of the following day.

NOTE C: Free time and charges will be determined by the provisions of Norfolk Southern's tariffs, and advanced by carrier.

ITEM 501-1 RAILROAD EQUIPMENT USE CHARGES (PER DIEM) (c)

When a consignor or consignee is unable to load or unload a vehicle in their custody within the free time specified herein, charges will be determined by the provisions of the Norfolk Southern or CSX Railroad tariff and advanced if necessary by carrier.

ITEM 501-2 DETENTION OF TRAILER OR CONTAINER AT CARRIER'S TERMINAL

- (a) When consignor or consignee requests carrier to store container or trailer at carrier's terminal, or other secure location, the charge for such storage will be assessed to persons making such request at a charge of \$30.00 per day, or fraction thereof, per container or trailer.

ITEM 501-3 RE-SPOTTING OF CONTAINERS

- (a) When shipments are being transported, or a driver and tractor stay with for unloading basis, trailers or containers may be re-spotted within the continuous property of the shipper or consignee, subject to detention charges under Item 500 herein from the time of arrival of the vehicle for initial loading or unloading until the release of the vehicle after loading or unloading is completed and shipping documents have been turned over to the driver of carrier's vehicle.
- (b) When shipments are transported on a "drop and pull" basis, trailers or containers will be re-spotted within the continuous private property of shipper or consignee, provided the locations involved are not more than one-half mile apart, and subject to charges in column B of Item 2300, tariff CASR 200-Series (NOTE A).

NOTE A: Applicable also on the transportation of empty trailers.

ITEM 520 EQUIPMENT -
CONTAINER OR TRAILER SPECIFICATIONS

- (a) Containers or trailers of the closed type must be equipped with closed side or end doors, tightly fitted with suitable locking and sealing devices. Shipper must provide locks and/or seals to adequately secure doors to protect the lading. Locks or seals placed by shipper will be removed by the consignee, and the carrier assumes no responsibility for their return.
- (b) All container or trailer must be suitably equipped with tie down brackets and in such condition as to permit safe handling in railroad and motor carrier service.
- (c) All containers or trailers must be equipped with lighting, safety and protective devices and equipment prescribed by the U.S. Department of Transportation.
- (d) Trailers may not exceed:
- (1) 53 feet in length outside measurement
 - (2) 8 feet 6 inches in width outside measurement
 - (3) 8 feet 6 inches in width outside wall of tire to outside wall of tire
 - (4) 13 feet 6 inches in height overall measurement

◆ ITEM 520-1 EQUIPMENT -
USE OF CARRIER'S CHASSIS

SECTION I: (NOTE A)

- (a) When carrier is required to provide a chassis for the movement of containers, a charge of \$130.00 will be assessed. In addition to all other applicable charges.
- (b) The initial charge will include use of the chassis for three days. When the chassis is not returned to carrier within such time, and additional charge of \$30.00 per day for each day in addition to the free days will be assessed, until the movement is completed.

SECTION II:

Where a chassis is provided in accordance with the operation of a railroad, steamship line, CY yard or any other chassis providing facility's chassis pool, a charge of \$30.00 per day will apply, in addition to all other applicable charges.

ITEM 520-2

EQUIPMENT --
CARRIER'S RESPONSIBILITY FOR SHIPPER'S TRAILER OR CONTAINER

- (a) Carrier will be responsible for custody and possession of shipper's trailer only to the extent of reasonable care in the performance of its function as a common carrier in the transfer of the shipper's trailer between the points named in this tariff. Carrier warrants that its power units are properly licensed and are covered by insurance for its liability in the operation of power vehicles.
- (b) Carrier is not responsible for the condition of shipper's trailer when accepted for transport under the terms of this tariff, and damage to shipper's trailer arising from any cause other than carrier's negligence or improper operation of the trailer, will NOT be accepted by the carrier. Responsibility for flat tires or other operational breakdowns arising from the regular operation of shipper's trailer in the performance of service provided by this tariff will NOT be assumed by the carrier.
- (c) In the event such breakdowns or malfunction of shipper's trailer occurs while carrier is performing services covered by this tariff, carrier will notify shipper of such conditions and will hold itself available to the shipper for any service it is able to render. Detention of carrier's power vehicle and driver will be subject to detention charges at the rates shown in ITEM 500 and will begin when driver notifies shipper of breakdown or malfunction. Cost of repairs, road service or other charges will NOT be assumed by the carrier. After container or trailer is dropped at the premises of the consignor or consignee, carrier will not be responsible for loss of cargo or for any damage to the container, trailer or its contents; consignor or consignee will be fully responsible for the delivery to the carrier of the container or trailer in the same condition as when dropped at their premises.

◆ ITEM 560

EXTRA LABOR

- (a) Carrier will provide additional labor not provided in connection with rates named herein upon request of shipper or consignee and such labor will perform additional service in connection with loading or unloading under the direction of shipper or consignee, in accordance with the provisions of this item.
- (b) When such additional labor performs loading or unloading of vehicle, the charge for such additional labor will be at the charge of \$45.00 per hour, or fraction thereof, per man. There will be a minimum of 5 hours labor per man charged. Travel time of one hour for New Jersey points, 2 hours for New York points and 3 hours for Connecticut points will be assessed, except that the travel time may be used as part of the minimum of five-hour period.
- (c) When the driver is required to load or unload freight onto or from a trailer or container, and additional charge of \$225.00 will be assessed.
- (d) When the driver is required to assist in loading or unloading freight, such as placing pallets for a slip-sheet load or using a power jack to remove palletized freight, an additional charge of \$150.00 will be assessed.

ITEM 567

HAZARDOUS MATERIALS

Shipments of hazardous materials requiring US DOT placarding will be accepted at the option of the carrier, subject to a charge of \$80.00 per shipment, in addition to all other applicable charges.

ITEM 595

MAXIMUM CHARGES

In no case shall the charge for any shipment be greater than the charge for a larger quantity of the same commodity in the same shipping form and subject to the same packing provisions from or to the same points over the same route.

ITEM 675

OVER WEIGHT SHIPMENTS

- (a) Consignor will be responsible to reimburse carrier for fines assessed for trailers or containers loaded beyond legal weight limits, unless carrier was negligent and the fine was caused by the carrier.
- (b) When required by law that the overweight be shifted or relocated within a trailer, or transferred into another trailer, charges for delay of power unit and driver will be chargeable at the same rate for detention of vehicle as shown in Item 500 herein. Charges as shown in ITEM 500 will also apply if carrier personnel are required to shift the load.

ITEM 750

PICKUP AND DELIVERY SERVICE

- (a) Except as otherwise provided, rates in this tariff include, as to each shipment, one pick up and one delivery service at all places within the limits of the cities, towns or villages to, from or between which rates apply.
- (b) Carrier shall not be required to render service at locations or sites which, by reason of the condition or roads, alleys, streets, consignor's or consignee's facilities, strikes, riots, violence or the threat of violence, or other situations or conditions which, in carrier's judgment, renders such operations unsafe, impracticable or impossible to perform.
- (c) Carrier shall not be required to render service at hours other than normal business hours (NOTE A), but will render such service subject to the availability of equipment and manpower.

NOTE A: Normal business hours shall be construed to include the hours of 8:00 AM thru 5:00 PM, Mondays thru Fridays, except Holidays (NOTE B).

NOTE B: Holidays shall include the following (NOTE C), on the day celebrated as such at the point of service:

New Year's Day	Independence Day	Christmas Day
President's Day	Labor Day	
Memorial Day	Thanksgiving Day	

NOTE C: Holidays shall also include those additional days celebrated as such at the point of service pursuant to local, state or federal regulation or pronouncement.

◆ ITEM 756

PICK UP OR DELIVERY SERVICE --
WEEKENDS, SATURDAYS, SUNDAYS, AND HOLIDAYS

When consignor or consignee requests carrier to pick up or deliver freight on weeknights (NOTE A) Saturdays, Sundays or Holidays (NOTE B), such service will be preformed under the provisions of this item:

- (1) The following charges will be assessed in addition to all other lawfully applicable rates and charges:

	Charge per man Per hour or Or fraction thereof	Minimum Charge Per Man Per Day
(a) On weeknights (NOTE A), other than holidays (NOTE B).....	\$25.00	\$125.00
(b) On Saturdays, other than Holidays (NOTE B)	\$25.00	\$125.00
(c) On Sundays or Holidays (NOTE B)	\$40.00	\$225.00

- (2) For services rendered on Saturdays, Sundays or holidays, time shall be computed from departure of vehicle from carrier's terminal until its return thereto. When pickup or delivery carries over to more than one calendar day, charges shall be assessed on the basis of the day on which service was commenced.
- (3) The carrier is not obligated to furnish pickup or delivery services under this item. If a delivery date is specified on the bill of lading and shipping order, and such date is subject to this item, the document must also indicate that the date noted is a Saturday, Sunday or holiday.
- (4) Charges must be paid either by the party requesting the service or guaranteed to the satisfaction of the carrier before pickup or delivery will be made.

NOTE A: Weeknights shall comprise the time from 5:00 PM thru 6:00 AM Mondays thru Fridays, other than holidays (NOTE B).

NOTE B: Holidays are those shown in NOTE B of Item 750.

ITEM 780

SHIPMENTS OF EXTRAORDINARY VALUE

Carrier will not accept for transportation any articles, which in its opinion are of extraordinary value, unless prior arrangements have been made.

ITEM 820

RECONSIGNMENT OR DIVERSON

- (a) Re-consignment or diversion will be deemed to mean a change in destination after shipment has moved en route from shipper's facilities, or carrier's origin terminal, if the shipment was brought to that location prior to commencing line haul transportation.
- (b) Carrier does not obligate itself to re-consign or divert shipments en route, but will make reasonable efforts to do so.
- (c) Shipments diverted or re-consigned will be charged for as follows:
- (1) When re-consignment occurs prior to dispatch from origin or carrier's terminal, the shipment will be charged for at the rate applicable from origin to new destination.
 - (2) When re-consignment occurs after dispatch as described in paragraph 1, the shipment will be charged for at the rate or charge applicable to the new destination, plus a stop off charge, subject to the provisions of paragraph 3.
 - (3) When the mileage from origin via original destination to new destination exceeds 112.5% of the direct mileage from origin to new destination, an additional charge of \$3.00 per mile will be assessed for such excess miles.

ITEM 820 (Concluded)

RECONSIGNMENT OR DIVERSION

- (d) Requests for re-consignment or diversion must be made or confirmed in writing. The carrier must be satisfied that the party making the request has the authority to do so, and receive sufficient guarantees for the payment of its charges, before re-consignment or diversion will be effected.
- (e) Only entire shipments will be re-consigned or diverted. Diversion or re-consignment of COD shipments will be accepted only from the shipper.

◆ ITEM 830

REFUSALS AND REDELIVERY

Shipments, which through no fault or negligence of the carrier, are not accepted by consignee upon tender of delivery during normal business hours (NOTE A), or if consignee cannot be reasonably located, will be deemed refused and subject to the provisions of this item. Charges in this item are in addition to original outbound charges and all other applicable charges.

- (a) Shipments may be immediately returned to carrier's terminal or to the rail (if container is to be billed out to another location) without further notice at a charge of \$125.00 for deliveries to points with rate basis numbers less than 50. For refusals at points with higher rate basis numbers, the cost will be 80% of the tariff rate for a stay with delivery to that point. At carrier's option, carrier may contact the shipper while its vehicle remains in the general vicinity of the point of refusal to attempt to effect alternative disposition. Further contact with consignee may also be made in order to obtain alternative disposition of the shipment.
- (b) If so instructed, carrier will affect redelivery to the initial consignee at the point of refusal at a charge of \$65.00, if carrier's vehicle remained in the vicinity of the consignee's facilities and redelivery is accomplished on the same day as the original tender. If the shipment has been returned to carrier's terminal, additional tenders of delivery to the point of refusal will be made at the charge applicable to original outbound movement.
- (c) Shipments held by carrier at its terminal will also be subject to applicable storage charges.
- (d) Charges under this item must be guaranteed to the satisfaction of the carrier before transportation other than return to shipper or carrier's terminal will be affected.

NOTE A: Normal business hours shall include the time from 8:00AM thru 5:00 PM Mondays thru Fridays.

ITEM 890

SPLIT PICKUPS OR DELIVERIES

- (a) Pickup service may be provided at not more than three additional loading sites within the continuous private property of the party receiving such service, intersected by not more than one public street or thoroughfare.
- (b) Delivery service may be provided at not more than two additional unloading sites within the continuous private property of the party receiving such service, with intersected by not more than one public street or thoroughfare.
- (c) Re-spotting of trailers in the performance of services under this item will be subject to the provisions of Item 501-3.

◆ ITEM 891

SPECIAL SERVICES — REQUEST FOR POWER UNIT

- (a) When carrier is required by a shipper to supply a tractor and driver to perform other than line haul service noted otherwise provided herein, such tractor and driver would be furnished at a charge of \$65.00 per hour or fraction thereof.
- (b) Charges will be assessed from the time driver leave carrier's terminal at 275 Pacific St, Newark, NJ, until return thereto.

ITEM 891

STOPOFFS

Truckload shipments may be stopped in transit at any point or place for the purpose of partial loading or unloading under the following conditions:

- (a) All freight charges shall be prepaid in full at one time, by one party, be that shipper, consignee, or other named party.
- (b) Only one bill of lading and one shipping order will be issued for the entire shipment.
- (c) Only one party will be designated as shipper, and only one party will be designated as consignee thereon.
- (d) The names and addresses of parties and locations at which stop offs are to be made will be shown in the body of the bill of lading and shipping order, or on a separate paper attached to and made a part thereof. Such data will also include information sufficient to identify the material to be stopped, such as pieces, weight, and package markings, etc.
- (e) Stop off will only be permitted at point of origin or destination or at points between origin and destination when the mileage via highway route from origin to destination via stop off point (or points) does not exceed 12.5% of the shortest highway route between origin and final destination.
- (f) Except as otherwise provided, only three stop offs, whether for completion of loading or partial unloading shall be permitted. The work "stop" or "stops" as used herein means the stopping for the purpose of loading or partial unloading, not including the receipt of the original part of the shipment nor the final delivery at destination.
- (g) ♦ A charge of \$105.00 will be assessed for each stop as defined in paragraph (f), in addition to the rate provided for in paragraph (i).
- (h) Except as otherwise provided in paragraph (i), the rate from the original place of shipment to the place of final delivery will apply on the total weight of the shipment (the weight after completion of loading, if a stop for that purpose is made, or the weight before the first stop is made for partial unloading, if a stop for that purpose is made).
- (i) If the rate from any place where a stop is made for completion of lading is higher than the rate from the original place of shipment, such higher rate will apply; or if the rate to any place where a stop for partial unloading is made is higher than to the place of final delivery, such higher rates will apply.
- (j) Where the additional pickup or delivery is to be performed within the continuous private property of the shipper or consignee, the provisions of this item will NOT apply. Apply the provisions of ITEM 890 (SPLIT PICKUPS OR DELIVERY) herein for this service.
- (k) The substitution of other property for that originally loaded or unloaded or change of the load in any manner is prohibited.

ITEM 980

UNNAMED POINTS - APPLICATION OF RATES

- (a) Rates named in this tariff apply at all points and places within the limits of authority described in this tariff.
- (b) When freight is transported from or to a point not included in SECTION 2 herein, rates will apply to or from the next most distant point to or from which rates are provided. Where, by reason of divergent highways, two or more points qualify as "next more distant" the point with the lower rate shall apply.

ITEM 985

VEHICLES ORDERED BUT NOT USED

- (a) When an order is placed by a shipper on a Monday thru Friday (8:00AM thru 5:00PM) for a vehicle, and due to no disability, fault or negligence on the part of the carrier, the vehicle is not used; cancellation of the order must be made before the vehicle is dispatched in compliance with such order.
- (b) If cancellation is not so made and the vehicle is dispatched as ordered, a charge of \$15.00 per each 15 minutes or fraction thereof, will be assessed, computed from the time vehicle leaves carrier's terminal until its return thereto.
- (c) When a vehicle is ordered at other times than specified in paragraph (a) herein, charges will be assessed in accordance with the provisions of ITEM 756.
